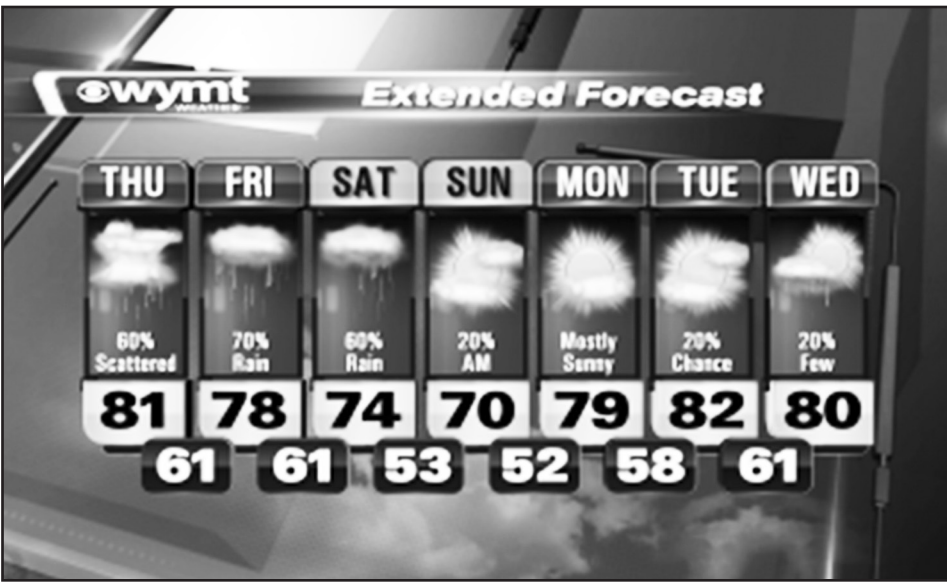

District Court News

Judge Hon. Allen B. Roberts 04-22-19

Martin, Cody failure to appear at pre-trial conference. Order over limit. Dismissed without prejudice with leave to reinstate for 1 year.

Hensley, Stephen Warren-No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; No/Expired registration plates; Failure to produce insurance card; Failure to wear seat belts; Operating on suspended/revoked operators license. Counts 1-5: Not guilty plea. Def says he is in rehab at Hope Center in Lexington, KY at "Jacob's House". Pre-trial Conference: 6-24-2019.

Abner, Robert E-No/Expired registration plates; No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; Failure to notify address change to dept of transp. Counts 1-3: Dismissed without prejudice with proof shown.

Anderson, Brent D-Failure to or improper signal; Operating on suspended/revoked operators license; Failure to wear seat belts; Poss controlled sub, 1st degree, 1st off (Methamphetamine). Waived days. Continue to 5-13-2019.

Baker, Fredrick-No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; Failure of owner to maintain required insurance/security 1st. Counts 1 & 2: Not guilty plea. Pretrial Conference: 6-24-2019.

Baldwin, Cristy-Theft by deception-include cold checks u/\$500. Sent court notice. Continue to 6-24-2019.

Biggs, Michael Wayne-TBUT all others \$10,000 or more but u/\$1,000,000. In Madison County Jail. Def to be trasported. Continue to 5-13-2019.

Crowe, Daniel L-Public intoxication controlled subs (excludes alc); Failure to notify address change to dept of transp. Counts 1 & 2: Not guilty plea. Court finds def qualifies and appoints DPA. Pretrial Conference: 6-24-2019.

Doan, Gregory-Drug paraphernalia-buy/possess-Dismissed without prejudice; Traffic in marijuana, less than 8 oz-1st offense-Amended to Possession of marijuana-Guilty plea, Sentenced to 3 days, CTS 3 days and court costs, 7-08-2019. Court finds plea is ki&vol. WOA served for

failure to appear at pre-trial conference. Order bond to be released to poster.

Estes, Megan Lynn-Drug paraphernalia-buy/possess; Failure to appear, citation for misdemeanor. Counts 1 & 2: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 10 days in jail, CTS 10 days. Court finds plea is ki&vol. WOA served for failure to appear at arraignment.

Fowler, Debra A-No/Expired registration plates; No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; Improper registration plate; Failure to appear, citation for misdemeanor. Counts 3 & 6: Guilty plea, \$25-suspended and court costs, 7-08-2019. Count 6: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 15 days in jail, CTS 15 days. Bond to be released to poster. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Fox, Jobie Austin-TBUT or disp shoplifting u/\$500. FTA-BW \$500.

Gambill, Travis-Assault 4th degree minor injury-Dismissed without prejudice; Criminal trespass-1st degree-Guilty plea, Sentenced to 6 months, CTS 18 days, CD for 2 years, No contact with Darla Gambill or her property. Court finds plea is ki&vol. Parties agree def may get personal items from Darla Gambill's residence on 4-30-2019 at 11 am and on another date to be agreed upon.

Gambill, Travis-Criminal trespass-1st degree. Guilty plea, Sentenced to 6 months in jail, CTS 18 days, CD for 2 years and court costs, 7-08-2019. No contact with Darla Gambill except to pickup property and get clothing 4-30-2019 at 11 am. Parties agree one addition day shall be agreed upon to get remainder of def's property within 90 days. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Harr, Jay Weston-Disposal at other than permitted site-open dump. Waived days. Continued to 5-29-2019.

Harvey, Roger-Wanton endangerment-1st degree-Amended to Criminal attempt; Terroristic threatening, 3rd degree; Unlawful imprisonment-1st degree. Count 1: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 360 days in jail, CTS 4 days, 2 years CD and

court costs, No violent contact with Rhonda Harvey, Def to attend inpatient treatment for alcohol, 7-08-2019. Counts 2 & 3: Dismissed without prejudice. Review: 5-29-2019.

Hensley, James P-Wanton endangerment-1st degree-Police officer; Wanton endangerment-1st degree; Fleeing or evading police, 1st degree; Operating on suspended/revoked operators license. Counts 1-4: Not guilty plea. Court finds def qualifies and appoints DPA. Preliminary Hearing: 5-26-2019.

Hensley, Stephen Warren-Theft by deception-include cold checks u/\$500. Not guilty plea. Pretrial Conference: 6-24-2019.

Horn, Bradley-Alcohol intoxication in a public place-1st & 2nd; Failure to appear, citation for misdemeanor. Counts 1 & 2: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 10 days, CTS 10 days. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Horn, Larry Bradley-Burglary, 2nd degree; Terroristic threatening, 3rd degree; Violation of Kentucky E.P.O./D.V.O.; Menacing; TBUT or disp all others u/\$500. Def waives days on preliminary hearing. Preliminary Hearing: 5-13-2019.

Hundley, Benjamin-Alcohol intoxication in a public place-1st & 2nd; Attempted Wanton endangerment-1st degree; Menacing; Disorderly conduct, 2nd degree; Resisting arrest; Attempted assault-3rd degree-police/probation officer-identi; Attempted wanton endangerment-1st degree-police officer; Obstructing governmental operations. Counts 1-8: Guilty plea, Sentenced 360 days in jail, CD for 2 years and court costs, 7-08-2019. Interpreter. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Jones, Melissa-No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt-Dismissed; Improper registration plate-Guilty plea, \$25 and court costs, 7-08-2019; Failure to produce insurance card-Dismissed without prejudice with proof shown.

King, Kyra-Giving officer false identifying information. Guilty plea, Sentenced to 60 days, CD for 2 years, CTS 16 days. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

King, Kyra-Drug paraphernalia-buy/possess; Poss cont sub, 2nd degree-drug unspecified; Controlled substance prescription not in orig container 1st. Counts 1 & 2: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 120 days in jail, CTS 16 days, CD for 2 years and court costs, 7-08-2019. Count 3: Dismissed without prejudice. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Marcum, Danny Wayne-Failure to produce insurance card; Oper mtr veh u/influence alc/drugs/etc. .08-3rd off. OPS is pre-trial suspended; Waived days. Continued to 7-22-2019 to enter plea.

Morgan, Fred-Failure to wear seat belts; Failure to produce insurance card; Operating on suspended/revoked operators license; Improper equipment; Failure to appear, citation for misdemeanor; Failure to appear, citation for misdemeanor. Sent court notice.

Morgan, John H-Local county ordinance; Local burning ban; Criminal littering. FTA-BW \$250.

Parks, Clinton T-No/Expired registration plates; No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; Failure to produce insurance card. Counts 1-3: Dismissed without prejudice with proof shown. Proof of insurance, registration filed.

Perry, Judy-Terroristic threatening, 3rd degree. Guilty plea, Sentenced to 6 months in jail, CTS 2 days, CD for 2 years and court costs, 7-08-2019. Court finds plea is ki&vol. No contact with Stephanie and Thomas Phillips.

Peters, Jordan Tyler-TICS, 1st degree, 1st offense (<2 gms Methamphetamine); Traffic in marijuana, less than 8 oz-1st offense; Driving DUI suspended license-1st offense, aggravator; Drug paraphernalia-buy/possess. Waived days. Continued by agreement to 5-13-2019.

Setser, Amanda N-Rear license not illuminated; Failure of owner to maintain required insurance/security 1st; Drug paraphernalia-buy/possess; Op mv under/influence of alcohol/drugs, etc. .08 1st off; Poss controlled sub, 1st degree, 1st off (Methamphetamine)-Amended to Criminal Attempt. Counts 1 & 3: Dismissed without prejudice with proof shown. Count 4: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 2 days in jail, CTS 2 days, DUI service fee and court costs, License is suspended for 60 days, ADE, 7-08-2019. Count 5: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 360 days in jail, CTS 2 days, CD for 2 years. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Shelton, Steven Gregory-Resisting arrest; Public itoxication controlled subs (excludes alc);

Terroristic threatening, 3rd degree; Menacing; Assault-3rd degree-police/probation office-identi-Amended to Assault-4th degree-police/probation officer-ideti; Disorderly conduct, 2nd degree; Criminal mischief-2nd degree. Counts 1 & 5: Guilty plea, Sentenced to 360 days in jail, CTS 23 days, 2 years CD, To enter and complete DC and court costs, 7-08-2019. Counts 2-4 & 6 & 7: Dismissed without prejudice. Waived days. Def accepted into drug court. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Smith, Jesse-Non support. Not guilty plea. Court finds def qualifies and appoints DPA. Charge on citation is non-support. Charge on criminal summons is flagrant non-support. Pretrial Conference: 7-08-2019.

Smith, Jonathan R-Speeding 15 mph over limit-Amended to 5 mph. Guilty plea, \$10 and court costs, 7-08-2019.

Trent, Whitney L-No/Expired registration plates; No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; Failure to produce insurance card. Counts 1-3: Dismissed without prejudice with proof shown. Proof of registration and insurance filed on 4-23-2019.

Turner, Larry W-No/Expired registration plates; No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; Failure of owner to maintain required insurance/security 1st; Failure to produce insurance card; Obstructed vision and/or windshield; Failure to notify address change to dept of transp; Failure to register transfer of motor vehicle. Counts 1-3 & 5 & 7: Dismissed without prejudice. Count 4: Guilty plea, \$50 and court costs, 7-08-2019. Count 6: Dismissed without prejudice with proof shown.

Witt, Randall-Alcohol intox in public place-3rd or > off w/12 mo)-Amended to Alcohol intox in public place-1st & 2nd. Guilty plea, Sentenced to 2 days in jail, CTS 2 days. Court finds jail time is in lieu of fine. Sent court notice (Must bring proof of emergency room visit on 04/15/19).

Witt, Randall-Alcohol intoxication in a public place-1st & 2nd o. Guilty plea, Sentenced to 1 day in jail, CTS 1 day. Court finds jail time is in lieu of fine. Set court notice (must bring proof of emergency room visit on 04/15/19).
