District Court News 09-27-21 Hon. Henria Bailey-Lewis

Rose, Alexis Kaitlyn-Drug paraphernalia-Buy/Possess. Guilty plea, \$100 and court costs, January 3, 2022. Has warrant added per request of defendant. Bench warrant is recalled and set aside. Court finds plea is ki&vol.

Simpson, Rufus Keith-Failure to wear seat belts; Operating vehicle with expired operators license; No/Expired Kentucky registration receipt; No/Expired registration plates; Failure of nonowner operator maintain required insurance 2nd or >. Count #1: Guilty plea, \$25, January 3, 2022. Counts #2-5: Dismissed without prejudice. Active warrant; Filed proof of drivers license; Insurance-Does not have vehicle identifiers. Recall and set aside bench warrant.

Young, Phillip-Operating on suspended/revoked operators license; Driving DUI suspended license-1st offense, Aggravator; Failure to produce insurance card. Bonded for that day. Continue to October 18, 2021.

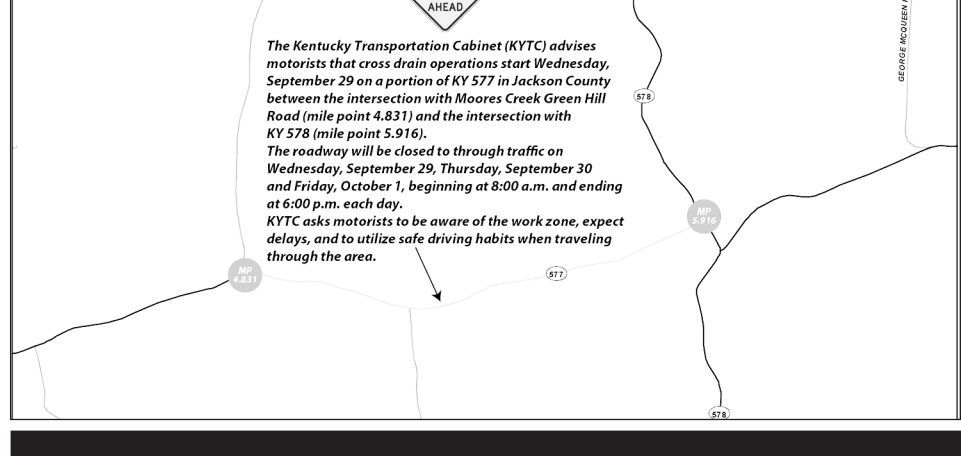
Wilson, Gary-Local county ordinance. Defendant to sign up for garbage pickup and provide proof. Continue to November 22, 2021 at 9:30 am.

Cross Drain Operations Start Wednesday, Sept. 29 on a Portion of KY 577 in Jackson County

MANCHESTER, Ky. (September 28, 2021) – The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) advises motorists that cross drain operations start Wednesday, September 29 on a portion of KY 577 in Jackson County between the intersection with Moores Creek Green Hill Road (mile point 4.831) and the intersection with KY 578 (mile point 5.916).

The roadway will be closed to through traffic on Wednesday, September 29, Thursday, September 30 and Friday, October 1 beginning at 8:00 a.m. and ending at 6:00 p.m. each day.

KYTC asks motorists to be aware of the work zone, expect delays, and to utilize safe driving habits when traveling through the area.
