Water Superintendent

The Water Plant Superintendent is responsible for the supervision of all Water plant employee's and the operation of the Water plant. The Superintendent is also responsible for a variety of construction and maintenance equipment and for performing manual activities as needed and/or required by the Public Works Department. Workers in this position may be utilized in other departments as needed. This position requires that the superintendent follow all regulations and laws pertaining to the operation of the Water Plant and Water Distribution system. Ensure that forms and records are entered and submitted in a timely and accurate manner. The superintendent shall follow and enforce all parts of the City of McKee personnel policy. This job involves both physical labor and sedentary duties, and may require the employee to lift up to 50 pounds.
